WORKS OF MERCY 101

"The **Corporal Works of Mercy** are found in the teachings of Jesus and gives us a model for how we should treat all others, as if they were Christ in disguise. They 'are *charitable actions* by which we help our neighbors in their *bodily needs*' (USCCA). They respond to the *basic needs of humanity* as we journey together through this life."

SHELTER THE HOMELESS

"There are many circumstances that could lead to someone becoming a person without a home. Christ encourages us to go out and meet those without homes, affirming their worth and helping them seek a resolution to the challenges they face.

- ~ See if your parish or diocese is involved with a local homeless shelter and volunteer some time.
- ~ Donate time or money to organizations that build homes for those who need shelter.
- ~ Many homeless shelters need warm blankets for their beds. If you can knit or sew that would be an extra loving gift.
- ~ There are millions of children and families who are on the move, fleeing from war, illness, hunger and impossible living conditions, and searching for peace and safety. Engage parish groups of children, youth, young adults, and families in doing some research on the causes and challenges that these families face to survive.
- ~ Contact Catholic Social Services, or diocesan offices of peace and justice for help with your research. Seek ways to provide shelter for the homeless locally, regionally, nationally or internationally."
