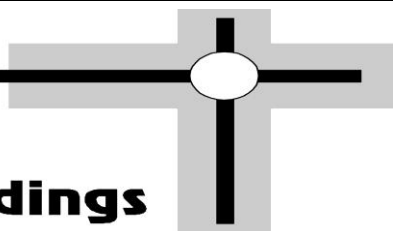

REGISTRATION FOR THE SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION

Graduating 8th Grade students that have attended a Parochial School or all 8 years of CCD Religious Education Classes are eligible to register for the Confirmation program. 10 SIGNS OF A SAFE PROGRAM FOR CHILDREN & YOUTH

1. **Screening** of staff / volunteers.
2. Adults trained in **safe environment strategies** and signs of abuse .
3. **Code of conduct** enforced.
4. **Open Communication** between parents and staff / staff and children / children and parents.
5. **Parents** always **Welcome**.
6. Children educated in **right relationships & what to do if a relationship isn't right.**
7. All children treated with **Dignity and Respect.**
8. **Clear Rules and Expectations.** consistent reinforcement / consequence.
9. **Adequate supervision of youth.** team approach—accountability—no 1:1 isolation
10. All **abuse** is **reported.**
