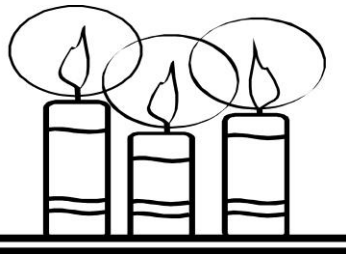

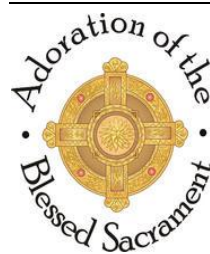

## WEDNESDAY EUCHARISTIC ADORATION

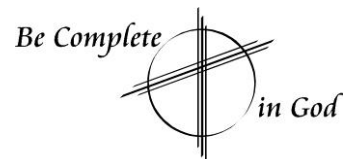
