Come and be blessed! Stay for an hour or even a few minutes. You'll be glad you came!

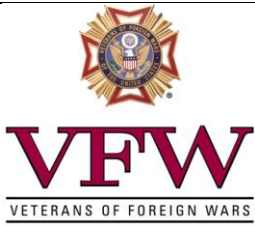

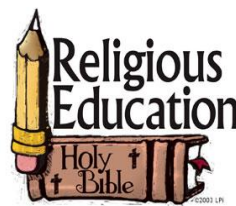
HISPANIC MINISTRY

SUMMER ATTIRE

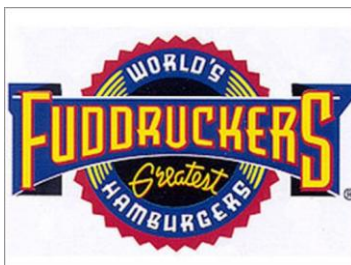
